
Male Anatomy Crossword



Down:

- 1. grape-like structure; secretes a significant portion of the fluid that becomes semen
- close proximity to the junction between the bladder and pelvic urethra
- paired muscles that clamps on ischium and reduces bloodflow
- 4. provides the gel fraction
- paired muscles that maintains the sigmoid flexure in a fibroelastic penis
- 7. sperm are produced here
- 8. cavernous tissue and connective tissue sheath the tunica albuginea
- 12. composed of connective tissue
- 16. spongy erectile tissue surrounding the penile urethra
- 18. outside of the urethralis muscle

Across:

- responsible for transport of sperm during ejaculation
- 9. sperm are stored here
- 10. sperm gain motility here
- 11. glandular tissue; lateral and dorsal walls of the pelvic urethra
- 13. testicular vein that intertwines around the testicular artery
- 14. composed of mostly erectile tissue
- 15. striated muscle supporting the testis
- 17. a single muscle that functions to empty the extra-pelvic part of the urethra
